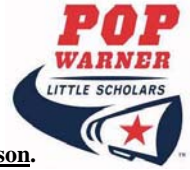

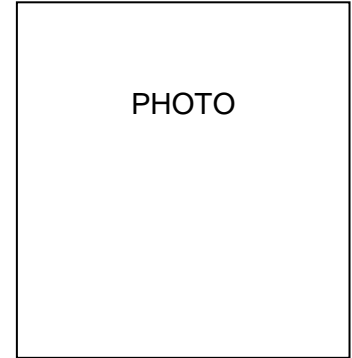

2010 Parental/Guardian Permission and Waiver Agreement

1. PERMISSION TO PARTICIPATE

Initial

I, the parent/guardian of the above-named participant hereby acknowledge that my child is in good general health and I give my approval for my child to participate in any and all Pop Warner national, regional, league/conference, association and team/squad activities, including transportation to and from the activities by a licensed driver with proof of insurance. I further grant OEC the right to use the likeness (such as photos & videos) of me and my child without compensation. I understand that OEC operates a program for disabled children, and that I may register a disabled child in said program.

2. INTENT TO INFORM

Initial

I acknowledge that I am fully aware of the potential dangers of participation in any sport and I fully understand that participation in football, cheerleading and/or dance, and related activities may result in **SERIOUS INJURIES, PARALYSIS, PERMANENT DISABILITY AND/OR DEATH to myself, my children, and/or entire family.** Furthermore, I fully acknowledge and understand that protective equipment does not prevent all participant injuries. Further, I do hereby forever discharge, waive, release, absolve, indemnify, and agree to hold harmless the team, local, league/conference (OEC) and regional Pop Warner organization(s), Pop Warner Little Scholars, Inc., and any and all organizers, sponsors, supervisors, administrators, officers, directors, staff, referees, participants, and persons transporting the above named participant to and from activities, from any claim arising out of any injury to myself and/or my/our child whether the result of negligence or for any other cause. I am aware of California Civil Code § 1542, which applies to the waiver of unknown claims, and I intend for this document to waive and release all claims, known and unknown. I understand that Civil Code of State of California Section 1542 provides: "**A general release does not extend to claims which the creditor does not know or suspect to exist in his favor at the time of executing the release, which, if known by him, must have materially affected his settlement with the debtor.**" and I am EXPRESSLY WAIVING ANY/ALL RIGHTS under the aforesaid statute.

3. EMERGENCY MEDICAL AUTHORIZATION

Initial

I hereby grant my permission for any and all emergency medical/dental treatment and/or first aid to be administered to myself and/or my child/participant, including authorizing any medical treatment facility/hospital to administer emergency treatment, for any illness/injury/accident resulting from, or occurring during, participation in any and all Pop Warner activities.

4. EQUIPMENT RESPONSIBILITY & DOCUMENTATION

Initial

I agree to assume full responsibility for the proper care and maintenance of any and all equipment/uniforms loaned to myself and/or the above named participant and I agree to promptly return, upon request (but in no case later than December 31st of the current calendar year), the equipment/uniform and other equipment issued to myself and/or the above named participant in as good condition as when received except for normal wear and tear. If I fail to adhere to this policy, I will be responsible for the **full replacement cost** of such equipment/uniform. I agree to furnish an authentic certified copy of a birth certificate of the above-named participant to local Pop Warner officials, and that falsification of any documentation provided by me will be cause for disciplinary action. I agree to provide any other documentation required by the association and/or league, including multiple copies of same. I hereby consent to receive communications via email and mail from any Pop Warner entity.

5. INSURANCE DISCLOSURE

Initial

I am aware that my Pop Warner league (OEC) carries Accidental Insurance Coverage for hospital and medical expenses related to approved Pop Warner activities, which is considered secondary or excess for medical purposes to any and all valid insurance I possess is considered primary insurance. Furthermore, I agree to notify in writing my head coach and local Pop Warner organization of any medical claim as a result of participation in Pop Warner activities WITHIN TWENTY (20) DAYS of the injury. I understand that any registration fee paid does not constitute a direct premium for insurance and that a deductible(s) may apply to each injury and that a maximum coverage may also apply.

6. SCHOLASTIC VERIFICATION

Initial

I hereby stipulate that I will provide any and all documentation (such as report cards and scholastic eligibility forms) necessary to verify scholastic fitness to the satisfaction of local, league, and national Pop Warner officials. Additionally, I will provide any necessary follow-up documents pertaining thereto (such as progress reports). Furthermore, I hereby authorize my child's school to release school grades, report card results, and any and all other pertinent scholastic information to the local Pop Warner organization in order to comply with Pop Warner's scholastic fitness requirements. I hereby stipulate that scholastic fitness, as defined by Pop Warner Little Scholars, is a requirement to participate in Pop Warner activities and that the interpretation of such fitness is at the sole discretion of the league.

7. FINANCIAL/PARTICIPATION RESPONSIBILITY

Initial

I hereby stipulate that I have been advised by the local Pop Warner Organization of my rights, if any (I understand my local organization may have a no-refund policy), to a refund in accordance with the local organization policies, and I/we have also been advised of my fundraising obligations for the entire season and agree to fully comply with those obligations. Additionally, I hereby stipulate that I will perform tasks requested of me, such as, but not limited to, snack bar duty, fundraisers participation, game day chain gang duty, mandatory play rule enforcement, and the like. I hereby stipulate that I will comply with Conference Official directives.

8. ADULT CODE OF CONDUCT

Initial

S1: In order to uphold the goals of Pop Warner and ensure that all participants have the benefit of a safe and fun learning environment, all parents, guardians and other adults and attendees of Pop Warner events, including but not limited to practices, competitions, and banquets, must behave accordingly in a respectful, courteous and sportsmanlike manner at all times.

S2: Any adult who is using alcohol, tobacco or non-prescription drugs and/or appears intoxicated at a Pop Warner event, and/or who is flagrantly rude, attempts to intimidate, verbally abuse, heckles, taunts, ridicules, boos, throws objects and/or uses vulgarity or profane language/gestures with an official, coach, volunteer, staff member, participant or other event attendee, must receive a verbal warning and/or be asked to leave a Pop Warner event. The member organization may also provide a written warning to the individual regarding the misbehavior. The adult's children may also be removed from the event. Any adult who commits one of the above stated offenses a second time, will be banned from any and all Pop Warner events for a period of one year from the date of the second offense, and their children may also be removed from the program(s) for that time period.

S3: Any adult who physically assaults an official, coach, volunteer, staff member or participant or threatens grave bodily harm may be banned from any and all Pop Warner events for one year from the date of the offense, and their children may also be removed from any and all Pop Warner programs for that same period of time. After the ban has expired, if the individual commits another offense of the adult code of conduct, the individual will be permanently banned from any and all Pop Warner events and the individual's children may also be permanently removed from any and all Pop Warner programs.

9. SEVERABILITY

Initial

If any provision of this instrument is held to be invalid, illegal, void or for any other reason unenforceable, that provision will be severed from the remainder of this instrument and that determination shall not affect, invalidate or render unenforceable any condition, obligation, covenant or such other provision of this instrument so long as the instrument remains capable of performance.

10. RULES & REGULATIONS

Initial

I hereby understand and acknowledge that as a parent/guardian/participant of a Pop Warner participant it is my responsibility to comply with all codes of ethics, rules and regulations stipulated, adopted or recognized by Pop Warner Little Scholars Inc. or any of its member organizations, including but not limited to the Adult Code of Conduct, stipulated in Section 8 above and published in the Pop Warner Rulebook, including any interpretation of the aforementioned by OEC pertaining thereto. Any non-compliance with any of the aforementioned may be cause for discipline and/or dismissal of my child/the participant, myself, and/or any spectators or other persons affiliated with the undersigned and the above named participant. I hereby understand and agree that disciplinary actions may cross calendar year boundaries. I hereby agree that my child must meet all certification criteria, including, but not limited to, the current age & weight requirements on the official certification date without exception, and that OEC is the final arbiter of said certification criteria. I further agree that OEC shall be the final arbiter in determining if myself and/or participant is capable of participating in any OEC activity.

In consideration of participation in Pop Warner activities, and by my signature below, I hereby stipulate that I have read, fully understand and voluntarily agree to be bound to all of the above commencing the date signed until Dec. 31st of the current calendar year (or as extended by the league/conference) and that all information provided by me is, and will be, true and accurate.
